



**Marion C.W. Henry, M.D., MPH, FACS, FAAP
Associate Professor, Surgery and Pediatrics**

Dr. Marion Henry joined the Department of Surgery at Banner University Medical Center at the University of Arizona one year ago. A native of Pennsylvania, she earned her AB in Religious Studies at Princeton University and her MD at Stanford University. She completed her General Surgery residency at Yale New Haven Hospital after completing an MPH degree in clinic research and biostatistics during her residency research time. Following residency, she was an active duty General Surgeon for the US Navy in Twentynine Palms, California. She subsequently did her fellowship training in Pediatric Surgery at Children's National Medical Center in Washington, DC.

Prior to moving to Tucson, Dr. Henry was a Pediatric Surgeon at the Naval Medical Center in San Diego. She also served as the Ship's Surgeon on the USS Carl Vinson, one of the Navy's Nuclear-Powered Aircraft Carriers, and as the Director for Surgical Services during Pacific Partnership 2015 on the USNS Mercy, one of the two Navy Hospital Ships. During this mission, she and her division provided surgical services to patients in four countries in Oceania and Southeast Asia.
